Persistent Fever Profile (Day 4–7)

- ◆ Malaria Antigen
- ◆ Peripheral Smear

- ◆ Serum Creatinine

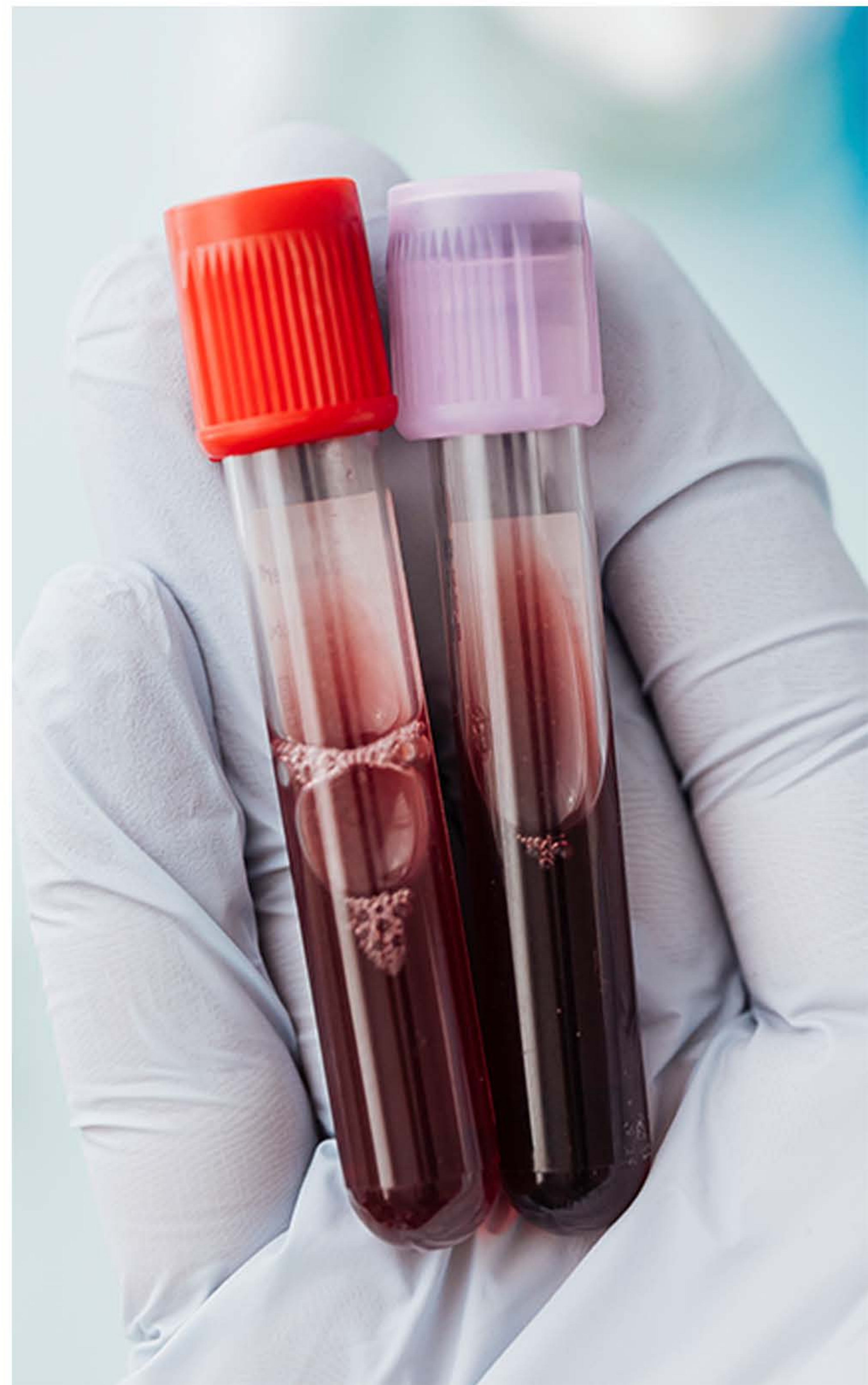
